



THE PARAGLIDING WORLD CUP

25TH OF MAY TO THE 1ST OF JUN-19

Following in the footsteps of the two previous World Cups in 2014 and 2017, Cœur de Savoie will once again be hosting a leg of the Paragliding World Cup from the 25th of May to the 1st of June.

In the commune of Chamousset, at the 'Ferme des Gabelins,' the elite of the paragliding world will once again be reunited. As in 2017, the organisation will be run by the association, Air Événement, led by Philippe Roéa, assisted by a large team of volunteers and helpers. Cœur de Savoie is made up of 43 communes (the Cantons of Montmélian, La Rochette, Saint-

Pierre D'Albigny, and Chamoux-sur-Gelon) and has a population of nearly 38,000 inhabitants. It is situated in the heart of the Alpine crescent at the foot of the Bauges and Chartreuse massifs and the Belledonne chain. 125 of the world's elite pilots will be taking part and thousands of visitors are expected. The length of each task will be between 40 and 150 km.

THE MAIN SITES WHICH WILL BE USED ARE:

A world first in paragliding competitions: Air Evènement's TV channel will be transmitting the competition live in French and in English.

The organisers are expecting more than 300,000 web spectators worldwide, which is an audience comparable to a French news channel.

KEY MOMENTS WILL BE SHOWN LIVE:

- Each task will be analysed by a personality from the world of paragliding.
- The take off will be shown live.
- The Start will be shown live and via on-board cameras.
- The race will be followed live by two tandem teams and via three onboard cameras.
- The arrival in goal will be filmed live.
- Interview with the winner of the day.
- Numerous TV shows with discussions about flying!
